 - I. 2020 Distance Learning Phase I
 - 1. Distance learning format. No instruction on Mondays. Teachers are doing preparation work, students are doing autonomous work. Tuesday through Friday in virtual class.
 - II. Phase II (pending)
 - 1. Two cohorts, each class split in half. Classes taught in morning and afternoon. Mondays dedicated to autonomous learning, teacher preparation, parent meetings, etc.
 - III. State of the school
 - 1. 99% parent overall satisfaction, 100% staff overall satisfaction. AP success rate of 55%. Graduation rate 88%. Of those graduating, 90% have college plans, 3% have vocational plans, and the rest are undecided.
 - IV. Questions
 - 1. AP success rate by demographic compared to national statistics?
 - a. Do not have the information.
 - 2. Did you ask any qualitative questions about college?
 - a. Graduation plan data comes from sessions with the counselor. Results are specific, not general.
 They are actively pursuing a specific college. All





who applied to college got into their first choice. Follow up in the works.
